An effective solution to improve treatment outcomes and Patient Assistance Program sustainability

At Axios, we believe sustainable access to treatment isn't just about whether a patient can pay—it's also about when they can start. With over 28 years of experience in Patient Assistance Programs (PAPs), Axios has developed deep, real-world insight into the barriers patients face when accessing treatment. One critical finding: even when financial support is available, patients may still encounter obstacles that delay treatment initiation—and those delays can have serious consequences for medical outcomes.

To overcome these critical barriers, Axios International has developed On-Time Access (OTA), a new solution that complements Axios-managed PAPs by not only improving affordability, but also ensuring patients can begin treatment without delay and stay on treatment.

Personalized Models to Expedite Treatment Initiation in a Sustainable Way

Patients enrolled in an Axios-managed PAP receive a personalized plan outlining how much financial support they will receive to cover the cost of their full course of treatment, and how much they may need to contribute themselves. The level of financial support received by each patient is based on their financial capacity, as assessed through Axios' proprietary, validated Patient Financial Eligibility Tool (PFET).

But what happens if the financial support provided by the PAP is not sufficient, or cash flow challenges and reimbursement delays get in the way of that patient starting treatment right away?

As a value-added service to our existing PAPs, OTA offers several models to help patients who require additional support starting their prescribed treatment:





CASH GAP SUPPORT

BARRIER

Patient can pay for their share of the treatment cost, but these funds are not yet available because of personal circumstances or delayed reimbursement

SOLUTION

Patient borrows funds at zero-interest and pays back via a transparent and personalized plan once funds become available, or reimbursement is received

PARTIAL CONTRIBUTION ASSISTANCE

BARRIER

Patient cannot pay for their share of the treatment cost

SOLUTION

Patient receives additional financial support to cover their share
